Temporary Drilling Authorization Checklist

The following Items must be completed and submitted with your application form. Failure to submit all required checklist items within the application review period will result in an administratively incomplete application and non-issuance of a permit.

Item 1. A proposed well design schematic with specifications to include: the total depth, borehole diameter, casing diameter and depth, annular seal interval(s), annular sealing method, calculated grout volumes, surface completion specifications, and any other pertinent well construction information.

Item 2. A well development plan that describes the process for handling cuttings and fluids during the well development.

Item 3. The location of proposed well or existing well to be modified and the estimated rate at which water will be withdrawn from well.

Item 4. Other facts and considerations deemed necessary by the General Manager for protection of the public health and welfare, and conservation and management of natural resources in the District.
